



EVENT: 4th Zemun Half Marathon (Zemun Half Marathon – 21,1 km; Zemun 10K Race – 10,5 km; Zemun 5K Race – 5.5 km; Race of Future Champions – children race)

EVENT LOCATION: Zemun, Belgrade

DATE AND TIME: September 14, 2025, at 10:00 AM for the 21.1 km, 10.5 km, and 5 km races, with the children's races starting at 08:45 AM.

RACE PACKET PICK-UP:

Race packets (bib numbers) can be collected according to the following schedule:

- September 13, 2025 - Saturday from 2:00 PM to 8:00 PM (We will announce the location in due course)
- September 14, 2025 - Sunday from 7:00 AM to 9:15 AM (ONLY FOR RUNNERS COMING FROM OUTSIDE BELGRADE)
- Runners arriving in Belgrade/Zemun on the day of the race should notify the organizer earlier via email at zemunski.polumaraton@gmail.com (especially for groups arrival) so the organizer can prepare their race packets (bib number) and avoid congestion at the registration center.
- If a participant cannot personally pick up their race packet (with ID required), another person may do so on their behalf with the ID of the person for whom the packet is being picked up (this is mandatory).
- You will be timely informed about the location of the registration center i.e., the place for distributing race packets which can be collected personally or with the runner's ID document. Minors wanting to run any of the races (21.1 km, 10.5 km, or 5.5 km) can only pick up their race packets WITH written consent from a parent/guardian.

RACE CHANGE:

- Changes to the race entry will not be possible after registration closes as a precise number of medals will be made based on completed registrations. Medals for the "4th Zemun Half Marathon," "Zemun 10K Race," and "Zemun 5K Race" will vary in size.
- Changes to any registration details (runner's name, chosen distance, T-shirt size, etc.) can be made no later than September 11 and will incur a fee of 600 RSD (5 EUR).

RACE COURSE:

- The start for the "4th Zemun Half Marathon" (21,1 km), "Zemun 10K Race" (10,5 km) and "Zemun 5K Race" (5.5 km) is simultaneous (10:00 AM) and located in the center of Zemun (exact start location will be announced later).
- The "4th Zemun Half Marathon" and "Zemun 10K Race" route takes runners through significant landmarks of this part of Belgrade including Zemun Park, Gardos Tower, Madlenianum Opera and Theatre, Zemun Quay and Main Street. One lap is 10,550 m long. Half marathon runners will complete two identical laps.
- The route for the "Zemun 5K Race" leads participants through Zemun Park, over Gardos to Zemun Quay, and back to Main Street where the finish line is located.
- The course is measured with precision measuring wheel.
- During the race, you will notice "path cleaners" who will ride bicycles ahead of the leading competitors, so please heed their instructions to allow faster runners to pass you more easily. Thank you for your understanding.
- "Race of Future Champions" consists of 4 races by categories:
 - 1st and 2nd grade – 200 m (one race)
 - 3rd and 4th grade – 400 m (one race)
 - 5th and 6th grade – 400 m (one race)
 - 7th and 8th grade – 600 m (one race)
- The start for the "Race of Future Champions" is also in the center of Zemun (exact start location will be announced later) at 08:45 AM.
- The group of 1st and 2nd graders (one race) will compete in a 200 m section. Pupils of 3rd and 4th grades (one race) as well as 5th and 6th graders (one race) will compete in a 400 m section, while the group of 7th and 8th graders (one race) will compete in a 600 m section. The courses for all student races are flat. Girls and boys from the same groups (e.g., 1st and 2nd grades) will run together in the same race but will be awarded in separate categories (the first three boys and the first three girls). All participants of the "Race of Future Champions" who finish the race will receive a finisher's medal.



- For the "Race of Future Champions" early registration is not required by the organizer. Race numbers can be picked up with parental consent on race day in the starting area from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM. The number of pupils in the children's races is limited to 100 participants per race.

TIME LIMIT:

- The time limit for completing the "4th Zemun Half Marathon," "Zemun 10K Race," and "Zemun 5K Race" is 3 hours (180 minutes).

TIME MEASUREMENT:

- Each participant will receive a bib number with a chip for electronic timing in their start package.
- The race number must be worn exclusively on the chest/stomach and must be visible throughout the entire race.

AWARDS:

- HALF MARATHON, 21.1 km- Absolute M and F category (cash and commodity prizes for the first 3 places)
- 10K RACE, 10.5 km- Absolute M and F category (cash and commodity prizes for the first 3 places).
- 5K RACE, 5.5 km- Absolute M and F category (trophies and commodity prizes for the first 3 places).

- **AGE CATEGORIES FOR THE 21.1 km RACE:**

- 30- 39 years (M and F category)
- 40- 49 years (M and F category)
- 50- 59 years (M and F category)
- 60+ years (M and F category)

- Trophies are provided for the first three finishers in all age categories of the half marathon race.

- **MOST SUCCESSFUL COMPANIES** (21.1 km, 10.5 km, 5.5 km)

- Trophies are provided for the three first-placed companies in all racing disciplines.

NOTE: Each company can register an unlimited number of participants (employees, but the three best enter the final ranking, regardless of the gender of the contestants. Therefore, teams can be mixed (female/male).

REFRESHMENTS:

- Refreshments for all event participants are provided for the entire duration of the race and afterwards.
- Participants are requested to dispose of their waste near the refreshment zone.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE:

- The event organizer is obliged to provide professional medical assistance in case of need. Teams from the Emergency Service and the Red Cross Zemun will be responsible for providing medical assistance. ALL PARTICIPANTS ENTER THE RACE/EVENT AT THEIR OWN RISK.

WARDROBE:

- Changing rooms and storage of items/wardrobe is provided near the start/finish zone. Elementary School "Lazar Savatić", working hours of the wardrobe from 08:00 – 13:30.
- Wardrobe drop-off and pick-up is possible only with the race number.
- Participants are requested not to leave their documents, money, and valuables in the wardrobe. The organizer is not responsible for any potential loss of these items. Thus, participants leave their items in the wardrobe exclusively at their own risk.

BEHAVIOR RULES:

- It is forbidden to bring food and drinks into the wardrobe areas.
- All event participants are required to abide by the race rules and to respect other participants, marshals, volunteers, and the staff responsible for organizing the race.
- All participants are obliged to take care of the health of other participants and the audience.
- Any form of violence leads to direct disqualification and removal from the course.



CANCELLATION OF PARTICIPATION:

- In case of cancellation of participation by the participant, the paid entry fee is non-refundable. If a person who has registered is unable to compete, their entry fee can be transferred to another person no later than 3 days before the event, after which it will no longer be possible to change the runner's details.
- If due to force majeure, which by definition the organizer cannot influence (weather conditions, unforeseen events), there is a cancellation of the event, changes in the schedule of the event, or any other change that deviates from the published information, the organizer will do everything possible to hold an alternative event, if possible, on another date.

DISQUALIFICATION:

- Participants will be disqualified in case of using any means of transport during the race, moving outside the marked race course, swapping start numbers, unsportsmanlike behavior, and non-compliance with the organizer's decisions.
- It is also prohibited and punishable to display symbols that incite hatred on religious, national, racial, gender, age, sexual, or any other basis. The organizer has the right to disqualify a participant who violates this point or to take other measures deemed necessary.

RESULTS:

- Results will be published at the end of the race on the websites www.runtrace.net and www.zemunskipolumaraton.com

USE OF MEDIA MATERIALS:

- By registering for the event, participants agree that the organizer retains all rights to use, copy, and distribute all recorded audio, video, and photo materials and that the organizer may use all audio, video, and photo materials created during, before, and after the event for its needs and for promoting the event and sponsors. All photographs and video and audio recordings of participants recorded by the organizer during the event are the property of the organizer, and participants waive all rights to them as well as any potential compensation related to the use of these materials.

PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA:

- The organizer commits to protecting all personal data collected during registration for the event.
- The only personal information that will be publicly available on the participant list in the results are name, surname, and date of birth.
- Email addresses will be used for communication with participants related to the event itself, friendly events, activities, and promotion of sponsors, as well as for other events organized by the Sports Association "Taurunum Runners." All other data will be processed exclusively for statistical purposes.

CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT:

The organizer reserves the right to organize the race as a virtual event due to worsening epidemiological situations, about which participants would be timely informed. The organizer also reserves the right to cancel the race or set a new date due to weather conditions, works on the course, and other unforeseen circumstances.
